DSA-Sec allows P6 students to apply to some secondary schools before taking the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE).

They can apply based on their talent in sports, arts, academic areas, etc.

- If your child is admitted to a secondary school through DSA-Sec, they are **not** allowed to:
- Submit school choices during the Secondary 1 (S1) posting process.
- Transfer to another school. They must commit to their chosen school for the duration of the programme.

Who can apply

P6 students can apply for DSA-Sec based on a wide-range of talents, including:

- Sports and games
- Visual, literary and performing arts
- Debate and public speaking
- Science, mathematics and engineering
- Languages and humanities
- Uniformed groups
- Leadership

PSLE Posting Exercise

Interview Etiquette - Body Languag

After PSLE results are released, students are given the PSLE certificates and an option form to apply for the schools that they qualify for.

After 3-4 weeks, the posting results are released, and students learn about which school they will go to. Under DSA, students apply to join a secondary school before PSLE. After the application, students will have to undergo an interview or more, to be selected to join the secondary school (June Holidays to Term 3).

Upon successful application, students will be offered a chance to join the secondary school (partially based on PSLE results).

- Practise for the interview Get your parent/teacher to practise the interview with you
