Edusave Character Award (ECHA) 2021

The Ministry of Education (MOE) has introduced the Edusave Character Award (ECHA) in 2012 to recognise students who demonstrate exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions.

Eligibility Criteria:

- (a) Students must be **Singaporeans** and
- (b) Students must, on a consistent basis, demonstrate good character and values:
 - (i) <u>School values and/or character traits</u> that the school wishes to recognise or encourage, e.g. ICARE values; and/or
 - (ii) **A high level of civic responsibility**. E.g. Students who are concerned about issues in the community or issues faced by others, initiating action to address these issues to improve the lives of others, and being committed to make a positive difference; and/or
 - (iii) <u>Qualities associated with resilience.</u> E.g. Students who have persevered despite facing difficult circumstances (e.g. financial problems, family issues, health issues etc.), and managed to overcome the odds and still do commendably well in academic and non-academic domains.
